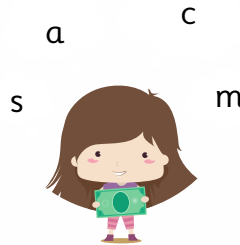

Why should you teach PHASE ONE PHONICS?

Supports children with developing sound discrimination skills for early reading and spelling

Develops sound isolation skills for segmenting and blending

Builds reading skills through oral blending and segmenting

Builds Vocabulary

Develops memory skills to aide with sound sequencing in words

Builds Communication

Enables children to identify single sounds
